

Get a Minnesota Tax Credit

You may qualify for refunds even if your income is below the tax threshold.

What is an income tax credit?

An income tax credit is a dollar-for-dollar reduction of the taxes you owe. Tax credits can lower your tax bill and may give you a bigger refund. They can be refundable, nonrefundable or partially refundable.

How do I claim a tax credit?

You may be able to claim one or more credits when you file your state and federal income tax returns.

How do I know if I qualify?

You need to meet eligibility requirements. These are things like, having a certain amount of income, your filing status and if you have dependents.
